Dear Mayor Melton,

On behalf of the Gary Firefighters Association IAFF Local 359, I want to express our full support for the proposal submitted by the City of Gary and Hard Rock Northern Indiana for the Lake County Convention Center.

As firefighters, our commitment to this city runs deep. Every day, we serve our citizens, protect our community, and answer the call whenever we're needed. But our dedication doesn't stop when we go off duty.

For the past couple of years, we've made it a priority to volunteer our own personal time—week after week, month after month—cleaning up our city. On our days off, we've hit the streets, rolled up our sleeves, and put in the work to restore and uplift our neighborhoods. This wasn't just a one-time thing—it is a real commitment because we believe in Gary.

I'm 55 years old now, and I've spent 25 years of my life serving on the Gary Fire Department. I've seen this city through its highs and lows, and for the longest time, it felt like Gary would never get its moment.

Now, for the first time, I see the dream taking shape. The energy is here. The momentum is real. For the first time in my life, it feels like everything is finally coming together. That momentum starts with Mayor Melton. Before he was our mayor, Eddie Melton did a wonderful job in the statehouse as a senator. He wasn't just respected, he was trusted. Now we finally can. Hard Rock is known all over the world. Everywhere they go, they bring business, jobs, and entertainment that help cities grow. Right here in Gary, Hard Rock Casino Northern Indiana has already proven itself as a major economic driver.

When it opened, everyone expected it to do well because of its prime location right off I-80/94, one of the most heavily traveled highways in the country. It's done more than just well, it's exceeding expectations, attracting visitors from across the region, and putting Gary back on the map as a destination.

With Hard Rock already bringing in thousands of visitors, the convention center is only going to add to that. This is the missing piece Gary has always needed. It's going to bring hotels, restaurants, and infrastructure back that we've had in the past. This has been missing for many decades.


